

CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

Pony & Horse Model- To be judged on conformation and manners.

Mares & Geldings Model: To be judged on handlers presentation and control of the horse or pony and manners of the horse or pony.

Model Championship: The top 3 ribbon winners in each of the pony, horse, mares and gelding section will be invited to perform in the championship class. To be judged on handler's presentation of the horse, conformation and manners.

Pioneer Division: Open to riders mounted on horses or ponies who have not competed in classes where they are required to trot around the ring with a group. To be judged on rider's position and control.

Introductory Division: Open to riders who have not competed in classes where they are required to canter. Ground poles to be completed individually. To be judged on manners, suitability, and way of going. Riders may not cross enter into classes where cantering is required.

Novice Division: Open to riders not ready to Canter in a group. Ground Poles to be complete individually. To be judged on manners, suitability, and way of going. Riders may not cross enter into classes where cantering in a group is required.

Open Division: Open to all riders. To be judged on manners, suitability, and way of going.

Starter Equitation: Open to Junior and Amateur Riders. Fences to be ground poles. Riders may not enter divisions with fence height 18" or above. To be judged on rider's position and control.

Opportunity Equitation: Open to Junior and Amateur Riders. Fences to be 18" cross rails. Riders may not enter divisions with fence height 2' or above. To be judged on rider's position and control.

Modified Equitation: Open to Junior and Amateur Riders. Fence height 2'. Riders may not enter divisions with fence height 2'3" or above. To be judged on rider's position and control.

Young Entry: Open to horses or ponies ridden by professionals, juniors or amateurs that are beginning their show careers. Judged on suitability to become a show hunter. Fences 2 or 2'3".

Advanced Equitation: Open to Junior and Amateur Riders. Fence height 2'3". Riders may not enter divisions with fence height 2'6" or above. To be judged on rider's position and control.

Hunter Hack: Open to Junior and Amateur Riders. To be shown at the Walk, Trot, and Canter. Rider will be asked to jump 2 jumps. May be asked to hand gallop, halt and back. Will be split by height if entries warrant.

Pairs Class: Riders compete as a pair. Pairs are judged on quality, conformation, soundness, uniformity, manners, paces and ability to work together happily as a pair.

Leadline: Open to riders age 7 and under. To be judged at the walk only with a handler.

INFORMATION

FEES:

\$15.00/ Class

\$35.00/ Bedded stall/day

\$25.00/non-showing horse

ENTRIES:

All exhibitors must provide the show office with a current negative coggins report for each horse brought on the show grounds. Entry form must be filled out completely, including all signatures, and must be accompanied by an open check before back numbers may be picked up. Pre-Entries are not required but are recommended.

SCHOOLING:

Schooling will be permitted the morning of the show from 8:00 AM – 9:30 AM

COGGINS: All exhibitors must provide the show office with a current negative coggins report for each horse brought onto the show grounds, regardless if they are showing. If the horse is showing, the coggins must be shown prior to picking up back number.

STABLING:

Limited stabling is available. Stalls will be pre-bedded. Please call or text your stall order in to **Tara Deckel (508-776-9247)**. Please note stall fees are per DAY not per night.

AWARDS:

Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded in each division.

Divisions may be split by age group or horse and pony at managements discretion based on entry numbers.
